

HOOD COUNTY.

(2613) Art. 812. Beginning at the northwest corner of Somervell county, on a straight line running from the crossing of east Bosque by the north line of Bosque county, to the southeast corner of Palo Pinto county; thence with said line to the southeast corner of Palo Pinto county; thence north to the southwest corner of Parker county; thence east with the south line of said county to a point lying due north from the upper corner of a three hundred and twenty acres survey, in the name of J. Lyon, and the lower corner of A. Farquhar's three hundred and twenty acre survey, on the northeast bank of Brazos river; thence due south to the northeast corner of Somervell county, being a point due east from the northeast corner of W. B. Smith's survey on Squaw creek; thence due west to said corner; thence south 60° west to the Erath county line, and to the place of beginning.
