2. Discuss Hood County Master Thoroughfare Plan as contracted to be developed by Teague, Nall, and Perkins, Inc. (TNP) with additional planning to be provided by the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG); and consider approving an Engineering Service Agreement with TNP for the Old Granbury Road Planning Study at a fee of \$228,000 plus service fees as specified in the agreement.
3. Discussion on Hood County's plans for the Volunteer Fire Departments and Texas Emergency Service expansion of facilities and equipment.
4. Granbury Independent School district will provide an update and summary of the current strategic planning.
5. Discuss and consider action related to the Christmas lights that hang from the courthouse to the poles at the corners of the square.
