

## **Disaster Restrictions**

**Executive Order Issued March 24, 2020**

### **Locations and Activities**

Public or Private Gatherings occurring outside a single household.

- Prohibited.

Elective medical, surgical and dental procedures.

- Prohibited.

Price Gouging.

- Prohibited.

Bars, restaurants, food courts, gyms, massage parlors, barbershops, hair salons, nail salons, tanning salons, wellness and beauty spas

- Prohibited

Persons residing in Hood County.

- Stay at place of residence
- Practice social distancing
- Leave residence for Essential Activities, or to work at Essential Businesses, Essential Governmental Services, Essential Critical Infrastructure, or to perform Minimum Basic Operations

All businesses except Essential Businesses.

- No public occupancy permitted.
- Minimum Basic Operations allowed.
- Social Distancing required.

Food Establishments (Including those at schools, hotels, motels; Excluding those at hospitals)

- In-house dining: no public occupancy
- Drive-in, drive-through, take-out, and delivery is permitted.
- Social distancing is required.

Worship Services.

- Services should be conducted online or by social media broadcast or in a single household residence.
- Needed staff can attend to produce audio/video or conduct services for transmission.
- All churches are closed for in person services.
- Social Distancing required.

Nursing homes, retirement and long-term care facilities.

- Prohibit non-essential visitors unless to provide critical assistance or for end-of-life visitation.

## Essential Activities and Minimum Basic Operations

Essential Travel, summary: Allowed to carry out activities specifically permitted in this Executive Order.

- Individuals may leave shelter to perform Essential Activities.
- Must practice social distancing.

Essential Businesses, summary: Blood banks, Dentists, Doctors, Healthcare providers, Home-based and residential-based care for seniors, adults, or children, Hospital clinics, Laboratory services, Medical research, Mental health providers, Pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies, other healthcare facilities, Pharmacies, Substance abuse service providers, Veterinary care.

All services to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the public.

Auto-supply and repair, bicycle repair, Building cleaning and maintenance, Businesses that supply products needed for people to work from home, Electricians, Exterminators, Food cultivation – farming, fishing, livestock delivery and shipping not open to the public, Food service providers, Funeral homes, crematoriums, cemeteries, Gas stations, Hardware stores, Laundromats, dry cleaners, laundry service, Legal or accounting, Mail and shipping services, News media, Plumbers, Security services, Social services, charitable organizations, Storage for essential businesses, Trash and recycling collection, processing and disposal, Warehouse/distribution and fulfillment, Weddings.

- Allowed to remain open.
- Social distancing required.
- Essential Businesses providing essential infrastructure should implement screening precautions to protect employees and all activity shall be performed in compliance with social distancing guidelines attached.

Essential Critical Infrastructure, summary: Businesses that maintain live animals, Childcare services, Construction, Financial institutions, Moving services and supply, Real estate transactions.

Work necessary to the operations and maintenance of the 16 critical infrastructure sectors as identified by the National Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Agency (CISA) including public works construction, residential and commercial construction, airport operations, water, sewer, gas, electrical, oil refining, roads and highways, public transportation, solid waste collection and removal, internet, and telecommunications systems (including the provision of essential global, national and local infrastructure for computing services, business infrastructure, communications, and web-based services), financial institutions, defense and national security-related operations, essential manufacturing operations.

- Allowed to remain open.
- Social distancing required.
- Essential Businesses providing essential infrastructure should implement screening precautions to protect employees and all activity shall be performed in compliance with social distancing guidelines attached.

Minimum Basic Operations: Operations necessary to maintain security, upkeep and maintenance of premises, equipment or inventory, including, but not limited to, the care and maintenance of livestock or animals; I.T. or other operations that facilitate employees working from home; Facilitate online or call-in sales performed by employees in a store or facility closed to the public; In-store repair services performed by employees in a store or facility closed to the public.

- Operations allowed for non-essential businesses.
- Social distancing required.
