Hood County COVID-19 Interim Update - 6-27-2020, 5 PM

75 total COVID-19 cases detected in Hood County residents since mid-March (39 cases in last 10 days).

We currently have active COVID-19 cases reported in healthcare facilities, government offices, childcare facilities, nursing homes, churches, restaurants, and other businesses across Hood County.

41 active cases now

Numerous current hospitalizations, most are isolated at home

4 total deaths (3 COVID-related, one more COVID-positive at time of death)

30 have recovered

97 positive PCR tests reported in Hood County (some repeated, some for residents of other counties)

3.9% positive PCR test rate

14 cases detected in residents of surrounding counties reported to DSHS and their county health authorities

Hood County remains at SUBSTANTIAL risk of COVID-19 transmission.
