Hood County COVID-19 Interim Update - 6-30-2020, noon

95 total COVID-19 cases detected in Hood County residents since mid-March (20 cases in last three days since my 6-27 report).

At least 14 more positive results are under review today.

328 tests are out awaiting laboratory results.

We currently have active COVID-19 cases reported in healthcare facilities, government offices, childcare facilities, nursing homes, churches, restaurants, and other businesses across Hood County.

- 97 total cases
- 57 active cases
- 5 current hospitalizations, most active cases are isolated at home
- 4 total deaths (3 COVID-related, one more COVID-positive at time of death)
- 32 have recovered
- 121 positive PCR tests reported in Hood County (some repeated, some for residents of other counties)
- 4.4% positive PCR test rate
- 15 cases detected in residents of surrounding counties reported to DSHS and their county health authorities

Hood County remains at SUBSTANTIAL risk of COVID-19 transmission.
