## Hood County COVID-19 Interim Update – 11-24-2020, 3PM

- This is an update based on numbers from reports received from our testing locations on positive cases in the community to DSHS for Hood County.
- DSHS Reports a total of 1935 COVID-19 positive cases have been detected in Hood County residents. (512 new Cases so far for the month of November)
- We are at 28 COVID positive deaths reported for Hood County residents. (2 new death this week)
- We have tested a total of 20,661 citizens in Hood County.
- Our TSA Regional Hospital Rate as of 11/22/2020 is 13.81%. 1.19% under the 15% threshold required by the state.
- 20 currently reported hospitalizations, all other active cases have been directed to self-isolate at home.
