Hood County COVID-19 Interim Update – 12-21-2020, 3PM

- This is an update based on numbers from reports received from our testing locations on positive cases in the community to DSHS for Hood County.
- DSHS Reports a total of 3466 COVID-19 positive cases have been detected in Hood County residents. (1109 new Cases so far for the month of December)
- We are at 39 COVID positive deaths reported for Hood County residents. (3 new deaths since the last update)
- We have tested a total of 31,524 citizens in Hood County.
- Our TSA Regional Hospital Rate as of 12/21/2020 is 19.71%. 4.71% over the 15% threshold required by the state.
- 15 currently reported hospitalizations, all other active cases have been directed to self-isolate at home.
