

## **VISITATION POLICIES/RULES**

- 1. All visitors must register online and be approved and schedule your visit online in order to visit (including children). Each visitor must be previously listed on the inmate's visitation list (including children). Visitors must be 10-15 minutes early to check in for their visit.**
- 2. No electronic devices (i.e. cell phones, cameras, laptops, etc.)**
- 3. No baby carriers, no bags or purses of any kind.**
- 4. No food or drink allowed.**
- 5. Only three (3) visitors will be allowed in the visitation room at any time. Anyone who is not here to visit an inmate will need to wait outside in their vehicle.**
- 6. A valid, non-altered or mutilated government issued ID is required for anyone over the age of 17. If the visitor is under 17 years of age, they must be accompanied by an adult.**
- 7. Extended visits are granted for anyone traveling more than 150 miles one way. Extended visits must be scheduled in advance. You must call the Hood County Jail to schedule an extended visit.**
- 8. Please keep all children under control. Keep all noise to a minimum. People are visiting and would appreciate being able to hear who they are talking to.**
- 9. Appropriate attire is required. (Females) No sleeveless or cut-off shirts, mini-skirts, halter tops, tank tops, spaghetti strap tops, or short shorts will be allowed.**

**ANYONE VIOLATING THESE RULES OR THE OFFICER'S INSTRUCTIONS WILL FORFEIT THEIR RIGHT TO VISIT.**
